#### The Old Testament Reading: Genesis 6:17-22; 7:17-23

"For behold, I will bring a flood of waters upon the earth to destroy all flesh in which is the breath of life under heaven. Everything that is on the earth shall die. <sup>18</sup> But I will establish my covenant with you, and you shall come into the ark, you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you. <sup>19</sup> And of every living thing of all flesh, you shall bring two of every sort into the ark to keep them alive with you. They shall be male and female. <sup>20</sup> Of the birds according to their kinds, and of the animals according to their kinds, of every creeping thing of the ground, according to its kind, two of every sort shall come in to you to keep them alive. <sup>21</sup> Also take with you every sort of food that is eaten, and store it up. It shall serve as food for you and for them." <sup>22</sup> Noah did this; he did all that God commanded him.

**7:17** The flood continued forty days on the earth. The waters increased and bore up the ark, and it rose high above the earth. <sup>18</sup> The waters prevailed and increased greatly on the earth, and the ark floated on the face of the waters. <sup>19</sup> And the waters prevailed so mightily on the earth that all the high mountains under the whole heaven were covered. <sup>20</sup> The waters prevailed above the mountains, covering them fifteen cubits deep. <sup>21</sup> And all flesh died that moved on the earth, birds, livestock, beasts, all swarming creatures that swarm on the earth, and all mankind. <sup>22</sup> Everything on the dry land in whose nostrils was the breath of life died. <sup>23</sup> He blotted out every living thing that was on the face of the ground, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens. #### The Responsive Reading: Exodus 20 Selected Verses


- P And God spoke all these words, saying,

And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. <sup>8</sup> But when Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord." <sup>9</sup> For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish that they had taken, <sup>10</sup> and so also were James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." <sup>11</sup> And when they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed him.


The Sermon: Romans 11:33-34

SUMMARY OF LAST SUNDAY'S Q3 VOTERS MEETING: Opened with prayer at 11:25am. In attendance: Matt Fobear, Dave Troyan, Nathan Fobear, Pastor Tom Naumann, Randy Wittorp, Nicholas Jakel, Carl Ryan, and Jim Lucas. Excused: Jeremiah Rosen, Mason Dzakowic, Ben Mueller, and Jesse Wilke... Minutes from the 2023 Q2 meeting read and approved... Reports: MMC to accept Pastor's report as presented... MMC to receive Elizabeth Wittorp into pre-communicant membership... MMC to release with regret Dan, Krista, William, and Levi Geschwind from church membership at their request... MMC to accept treasurer's report as presented... MMC to accept Financial Secretary's report as presented by President Carl Ryan... MMC to accept Trustee's oral report as presented; Trustees continue to investigate possible new building locations; Trustees request a procedure for finalizing a decision on a new property... No Board of Christian Education report... MMC to accept Outreach committee report as presented by President Carl Ryan... Old Business: 1) Benevolence budget category line: MMC to adopt the Board of Finance's recommendation to add a budget line item for benevolence (recommendation parts 1a, 1b, and 1d)... MMC to direct the Constitution Committee to consider the Board of Finance's recommendation part 1c for inclusion in the church constitution as a bylaw... 2) Anniversary committee budget: MMC to add \$1000 budget line item for Anniversary Committee... New Business: 1) Pastor's salary: MMC that we increase Pastor Tom Naumann's salary to match CLC code effective July 1st and direct the Board of Finance to make a recommendation at the Q4 Voter's meeting for an additional increase to Pastor's salary, to also be prorated back to July 1st with the additional request to present criteria for regularly evaluating the salaries of our called workers going forward... 2) Tech Committee Appointment: Matt Fobear appointed as the 2023 Tech Committee... 3) Board of Trustee's have requested criteria for narrowing down candidates for our next property: a. Specs: min 2400 sq ft assuming mixed use sanctuary, smaller location radius around Berkley. b. Schedule: January 2024 move in date c. Cost: \$4000/month. d. Any other assumptions, e.g. visibility etc. will also continue to be included in criteria... 4) Board of Trustee's have requested a written procedure for making a decision on a church property: MMC to adopt the Mt Zion Procedure for Leasing a New Building (attached), to bring and present the procedure to the congregation following the service on July 16th, and to call a special property selection meeting on July 30th to facilitate the leasing decision by the congregation according to the procedure laid out in the aforementioned document... 5) Calendar: MMC to approve the calendar with the Evangelism Workshop stricken to be rescheduled... Elders/Council/Trustees/Outreach meetings rescheduled for July 25th... Special Property Selection meeting scheduled for July 30th... Election meeting scheduled for Nov. 5th... 6) Lay services: MMC to call Randy Wittorp as primary, Dave Troyan as secondary, to conduct the church service on September 24th... 7) Next meeting date (Q4 Quarterly) set for October 1st... 8) Randy Wittorp appointed to Election Committee for 2024 elections... #### Mt. Zion Procedure for Leasing a New Building (adopted by the voters 7/9/23)

- The Voters will recess a special "Property Selection Voters Meeting" in lieu of adjourning the meeting.
- 2. The Trustees find a building to lease that suits the church's needs.
- 3. The Congregation is informed of the findings of the Trustees and encouraged to visit the building and pray about it.
- 4. The first Sunday after the Congregation has been informed, a Congregational meeting will be held. During this meeting, everyone will be given a chance to voice their opinions on the proposed lease building. The meeting will be streamed for those unable to attend.
- Subsequently, the special "Property Selection Voters Meeting" will have the
  option to resume and a vote will be cast on whether or not to sign a lease at
  this building. A quorum will be required and a supermajority needed to pass.
- 6. If the vote passes, the Trustees will be tasked to sign a lease agreement and the meeting will be adjourned. If the vote does not pass, the Trustees will continue to search for a building to lease and the meeting will recess.
